Other Events

- 1) **Brook Clean-up on Flockton Park (second session).** This event is organised by the Don Catchment Rivers Trust. It will take place on Thursday 5th April 2018, from 10am to 1pm. Meet at the car park at the junction of Beaver Hill Road and Badger Road. The DCRT will be providing equipment and refreshments. If you can spare an hour or so, the organisers will be grateful for your help. Please wear suitable clothing and wellies.
- 2) **Bluebell Walk:** will take place on Saturday 28th April, and will be led by Pat Howells. The meeting point will be Schubert Bridge, Beaver Hill Road, just below and opposite the Fire Brigade Training Centre (Grid Ref: SK 40813 85708). The walk will begin at 2 PM and end at 4 PM. As usual, the halfway point will be Severnside Meadow. Here, participants can choose either to return to Schubert Bridge by way of the Bridle Path, or to continue along the Valley Bottom Path and up the steep hill to the Edge to admire the wide panoramic view.
